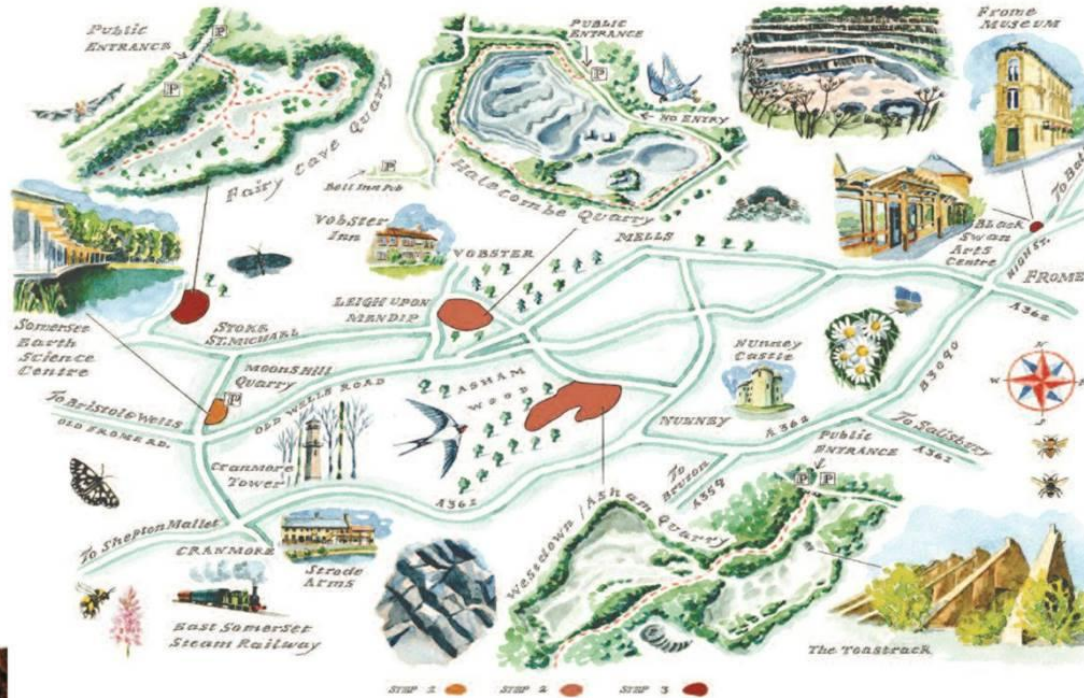

Fourteen leading local and international artists, all with connections to the South West, have created a series of site-specific artworks in response to the nature of quarries and their place in the cultural and industrial heritage of the region. You will discover fascinating sculpture, land art, photography, textiles, painting, drawing, sound, spatial poetry and printmaking ranging from the intimate to the extravagant.

Opening in July and stepping up in 3 phases to its finale in October, the event will occupy 6 different venues including 1 working and 2 disused quarries.
